Project Highlight

The Sikeston Airport Recovery Act project is a \$1.6 million dollar project that includes rehabilitation of the runway (5,500 feet long by 100 feet wide) and relocation of a portion of Campanella Drive (approximately 1,000 feet). The contract is for 180 calendar days with a completion date of mid December and to date they are approximately 80% complete. The engineering firm is Waters Engineering out of Sikeston and the construction contractor is ASA Asphalt out of Advance, MO. An aerial photo of the project was taken last week and shows the project progression.
