## News:

- Excellent job!! All of the \$112.5 million received in American Recovery and Reinvestment Act funds for transportation enhancement and sub allocated projects have met the required deadline for obligation. This has been a great collaborative effort between MoDOT, the metropolitan planning organizations, local public agencies and our FHWA partners.
- The Transportation Investment Generating Economic Recovery (TIGER) grants have been announced and Missouri will benefit from two of the chosen projects: Kansas City Transit Corridors/ Green Impact Zone Project and the Bella Vista Bypass.
- MoDOT reporting staff has completed several additional outreach visits in the southeast district. These visits concentrate on reporting compliance associated with the Recovery Act.

Highway Recovery Act expenditures to date	\$179.1 million
