


Associating Acrobat PDF to ProjectWise


For ProjectWise to automatically open PDF files with the Adobe Reader or Adobe Professional version installed on your PC, you will need to check and make sure you do not have any user associations applied for opening PDF files.

Please follow these instructions to remove any user associations for opening PDF files.

In ProjectWise, go to **Tools>>Associations>>Programs**




In the Programs Associations dialog box, change the association view to **User Associations**.



Navigate down the applications list to **Acrobat PDF**.
Expand it out by clicking on the **plus** beside it.
Then expand out the **Open** and **Viewer** options.

Scenario #1

If nothing shows up listed under the **Open** and **Viewer** options, your settings are correct and there is nothing else you need to do. Click **OK** to exit out of the dialog box.




Scenario #2

If you do have a certain adobe version associated, you will need to unassociate that version. This will allow to ProjectWise to automatically select the version of Adobe Reader or Acrobat that is installed on your PC.

To unassoicate the version, right click over it and select the **Unassociate** option. Do this both in the **Open** and **Viewer** options.

Click **OK** to accept the changes.



Once this has been done, you are finish. ProjectWise will now look at the global associations to find the version of Adobe Reader or Adobe Professional on the machine and open the application.
