DBE/EPG WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

DBE CERTIFICATION MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS

- Must be 51% owned by a socially and economically disadvantaged individual(s) who also controls the firm and has a Personal Net Worth of less than \$750,000.
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or lawfully admitted permanent resident of the U.S.
- Meet the Small Business Administration's (SBA's) size standard and does not exceed \$22.41 million in gross annual receipts.
- The firm must be a for-profit business.

Certification Regulations 49 CFR Part 26.61 – 26.73

DBE/EPG WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

January 2005, the USDOT approved the Unified Certification Program (UCP). The UCP was established by the Missouri Regional Certification Committee (MRCC).

Overall DBE Goal:

- Required to submit overall DBE goal request to FHWA for approval.
- FFY 2011 overall DBE goal is 13.50%
Based on availability and past utilization.

DBE/EPG WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

DBE GOAL SETTING CONT.

External Civil Rights reviews all federal-aid projects and determines an appropriate DBE goal for that projects.

The following are considered when establishing project goals:

- Location
- Dollar amount
- Types of work/Subcontracting opportunities
- Availability of DBE firms (ready, willing and able) for the type of work involved in the project
- Past utilization/history

DBE/EPG WORKSHOP OVERVIEW

Commercial Useful Function (CUF)

- The execution of the work of the Contract by a DBE carrying out its responsibilities by actually performing, managing, and supervising the work involved using its own employees and equipment.
- The DBE shall be responsible, with respect to materials and supplies used on the Contract, for negotiating price, determining quality and quantity, ordering the material, and installing (where applicable) and paying for the material itself.


