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(9) Permit Exemptions.

(A) The following types of activities, solid waste disposal areas or solid waste processing facilities are not required to obtain a permit provided that pollution, a public nuisance or a health hazard is not created:

5. The use of solid waste in the processing or manufacturing of products;

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- Importance of clean loads w/ minimal debris
 - On-site sorting of mixed loads triggers processing facility permitting requirements
 - Processing facility is “facility where wastes solid wastes are salvaged and processed”
 - 10 CSR 80-5.010 Processing Facility Regulations
 - 5% Rule of Thumb for debris in source separated shingle material
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- Must have viable end use and be able to provide documentation of usage
 - Long term speculative accumulation of loose or ground shingle may be considered disposal and result in enforcement action
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- Other options for beneficial use may be considered by the Solid Waste Management Program under Beneficial Use and Pilot Project Regulations
 - 10 CSR 80-2.010(9)(B)&(C)
